PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

We believe that the Parent Project is a partnership that honors the uniqueness of each family and promotes the abilities and strengths of those participating.

AS THE FACILITATORS OF THE PARENT PROJECT, WE AGREE TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Provide a trained facilitator who is available from 6:00 to 9:00 pm each Thursday night.
- Start class on time and end the class on time.
- Be available during the week and/or before or after class to answer questions.
- Listen with understanding and respect for differences.
- Respect the knowledge and experience of each person's own inner wisdom.
- Identify personal and community resources specific to an individual family's needs.
- Help tailor interventions/action-plans to an individual's situation.
- Attend each class 24-hours clean and sober.

In addition, we agree that information shared during the Parent Project® workshop is confidential. Information will not be shared outside of our meetings without explicit permission. However, disclosure is required by law when there is a reasonable suspicion of abuse or neglect of a child, an elder or a dependent adult; when there is a reasonable suspicion that someone presents a danger of violence to others; or when someone is likely to harm him/herself unless protective measures are taken.

- Try new things with an open mind. With the knowledge that things may not work "right" the first time, be prepared to share in class personal experiences to identify possible helpful modifications.
- Create and set aside focused time each week to work on the homework.
- Listen with understanding and respect for differences.
- Attend each class 24-hours clean and sober.
