

GreenWaste Collection Reminders



Palo Alto's new hauler, GreenWaste of Palo Alto, began servicing customers July 1. While the transition has been smooth, we would like to clarify some information about cart set out times and scheduling Clean-Up Day appointments. Here are the answers to the community's common questions.

Place Carts At The Curb By 6 a.m.

Although collection routes did not change when we transitioned to GreenWaste, the order of the material collected has been altered (yard trimmings are now collected before garbage). These changes, in conjunction with normal fluctuations caused by street work, truck repairs and alternate drivers, require that residents place their carts at the curb on their collection day by 6 a.m.

Schedule Clean-Up Day Appointments A Week In Advance

Clean-Up day collection requires one week advance notice for the following reasons:

1. Specialized equipment and additional personnel are required to handle the special needs of Clean-Up Day set outs (e.g., bulky items).
2. GreenWaste will send you guidelines on what, where and how to set out your materials.
