WHAT YOU CAN DO TO KEEP THE LIGHTS ON IN PALO ALTO

Let Canopy help you choose appropriate trees to plant under power lines. The City of Palo Alto Utilities and Canopy started "The Right Tree in The Right Place" program to help residents reduce tree maintenance and power outages due to overgrown trees.

You may be eligible for a free replacement tree and a rebate on stump removal through the program if your private tree is in "the wrong place" or is a fast-growing, frequently pruned tree that could cause conflicts with overhead utility lines.
