Conditions of Permit

A one week notice is required for noise exception permits. Special exceptions may be granted for emergency cases only.

A noise exception permit for a jobsite will only be issued when the applicant can clearly articulate why the job cannot be performed during regular working hours. The Palo Alto Police Department may modify or rescind this permit, based upon violations of the terms from separate reporting residents in the surrounding neighborhoods due to excessive noise created by your employees or equipment. **

When possible, vehicles and equipment should be positioned in locations that will be the least disruptive to residents. **Trucks used in the project are required to limit their reverse movements to reduce reverse gear alarm noise.** Please have employees refrain from using vehicle radios, personal radios or other sources of noise that are unnecessary for doing this work.

A copy of this permit is required to be at the actual work location and be available for review if requested.

The Exception Noise Permit fee is \$250.00. All fees are non-refundable. Checks are to be made payable to the City of Palo Alto and paid at the Police Department front desk located on the 1st floor of City Hall.

**Additional conditions may apply depending on work to be performed.

Below is a list of the city's holiday which work **cannot be done**

"Holiday" means and includes New Year's Day (January 1), Martin Luther King Day (the third Monday in January), Washington's Birthday (the third Monday in February), Memorial Day (the last Monday in May), Independence Day (July 4), Labor Day (the first Monday in September), Columbus Day (the second Monday in October), Veteran's Day (November 11), Thanksgiving Day (the fourth Thursday in November), and Christmas Day (December 25).
