

City of Palo Alto Adult Softball – Spring 2011 Registration Information

GENERAL LEAGUE INFORMATION

- The spring season will begin the week of March 14th. The Greer league will begin April 4th.
- Playoffs are generally in early to mid-June, depending on rainouts.
- Each league will consist of 12 games per team, plus playoffs for the top four teams. The spring league at El Camino will only be a 9 week plus playoff schedule due to maintenance work starting in mid-June.
- Up to 7 teams will be accepted for each league.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

How do I register?

Submit your completed registration materials with payment through one of the following options:

Office hours are 8:30 am to 5:30 pm, Monday through Friday.

When can I register?

- Wednesday, February 16th and Thursday, February 17th Returning teams only can register.
- **Beginning Friday, February 18th** Every team can register.
- **Registration Deadline -** Friday, February 25th, if space is available.
- If you want to ensure your spot in a league please register the first day you qualify.
- Only the completed roster and registration fee will reserve your spot!
- You may submit your registration materials earlier than the dates listed above, but your registration will not be processed until the first day for which your team qualifies and will be selected at random.
- Every registration received after Friday, February 25th, will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

How much does it cost?

- The fee is based on the makeup of your team:
 - Resident Team: \$680 (for full season) or \$523 for the El Camino League (At least 60% of players live within Palo Alto city limits) To qualify for this fee, proof of residency is required for each resident player and must be submitted with the roster.
 - Resident Corporate Team: \$715 (for full season) or \$550 for the El Camino League (Business must be located within Palo Alto city limits and at least 60% of players must be employed by the business) To qualify for this fee, a letterhead with the business address and a list of the players working for the business must be submitted.
 - Non-Resident Team: \$750 (for full season) or \$577 for the El Camino League (More than 41% of players live outside of Palo Alto)

What must be submitted at time of registration?

- League entry fee as listed above
 - Checks or money orders payable to City of Palo Alto, cash, Visa and Master Card are accepted.
- Team Registration Form

- **Tentative Team Roster** with a minimum of 12 players and their addresses.
 - ★ All players must sign the roster/waiver prior to beginning the first game. The roster submitted at the time of registration will be available from the scorekeeper at the first game. Players may also submit individual waivers instead of signing the team roster.
 - Each team must have a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 25 players.
 - A maximum of 5 additional changes will be allowed during the season. These must occur 48 hours prior to the second week of league play.
 - All players must be at least 18 years of age to be eligible to play.
- If registering as a Resident Team: Proof of residency for each resident player.
- If registering as Resident Corporate Team: Proof of business location and list of business players.

Who has priority?

Teams are accepted on the basis of our priority system. Listed below are the definitions of each priority ranking.

Priority	Definition	
#1	Returning Resident Teams: A resident or resident corporate team that has 50% or more players returning from the Spring/Summer or Fall '10 leagues.	
#2	Returning Non-Resident Teams: A team that has 50% or more players returning from the Spring/Summer or Fall '10 leagues.	
#3	New Resident or Resident Corporate Teams	
#4	New Non-Resident Teams

- Greer Leagues All games will be played simultaneously at 6:30 pm at Greer Park, 1098 Amarillo Avenue,
 Palo Alto. The games at Greer will begin the week of April 4th.
- El Camino Leagues* All games will be played at El Camino Park, 100 El Camino Real, Palo Alto. Projected game times are 6:30, 7:40 and 8:50 pm. The season for all leagues at El Camino will only be a 9 week plus playoff (March 14-May 27) season due to work being started on the fields in the middle of June. The fees for the El Camino League will be \$523 Resident, \$550 Resident-Corporate, and \$577 Non-Resident.
- **Baylands Leagues** All games will be played at the Baylands Athletic Center softball field, 1900 Geng Rd, Palo Alto. Projected game times will be 6:30, 7:40 and 8:50pm.
