


**A 75 percent fee discount is provided for classes for low-income and/or disabled residents. Income eligibility is determined using the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Low-Income Guidelines. The Low-Income guidelines are established at 62 percent of the Santa Clara County Area median income level. Palo Alto residents who qualify for the City's Fee Reduction can purchase hours of time for drop-in programs. The income level for disabled residents is established as 100% of the Santa Clara County Median Income.

*** For every 10 hours of time purchased in a Visual Arts Studio drop-in program, one hour is given free.
