On March 11, 2015, the City of Palo Alto was notified by LEED that they have completed their preliminary review of our most recent submittal. LEED, or Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design, is a green building certification program that recognizes best-in-class building strategies and practices. We have been awarded 84 of the 95 points that we applied for, which qualifies the project for Platinum, the highest certification offered
