Attend a free QPR (Question Persuade Refer) Suicide Prevention course on Tuesday, April 19, from 6pm-8pm at the Lucie Stern Community Center. QPR training helps you learn the signs of suicide, and what to do to help prevent this most preventable of deaths. QPR, modeled after CPR training, is an emergency response to someone in crisis. You will learn about myths and facts related to suicide; warning signs of suicide; how to ask the right questions; how to persuade someone in crisis to seek help; and to refer them to resources.
