



Application to Serve on the Storm Drain Oversight Committee

Authority of Committee:

The Storm Drain Oversight Committee is charged with reviewing the annual budget and expenditures of the Storm Drainage Enterprise Fund in order to ensure that revenue from the Storm Drainage Fee is being budgeted and spent in accordance with the terms of the storm drain ballot measure approved by a majority of property owners in 2005.

The Committee is responsible for:

- Performing an annual review of the proposed Storm Drainage Enterprise Fund budget,
- Performing an annual review of actual expenditures from the Storm Drainage Enterprise Fund,
- Adopt findings on an annual basis that the proposed budget and actual expenditures of the Storm Drainage Enterprise Fund are consistent with the spending plan outlined in the 2005 storm drain ballot measure, and
- Report findings on an annual basis to the City Council.

The Storm Drain Oversight Committee is composed of five Members who are not Council Members, officers, or employees of the City, and who are residents of, own property in, or employed within the City of Palo Alto. Terms of Members will be for four years.

The Storm Drain Oversight Committee meets at least two times per year and additionally on an as needed basis.
