RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PALO ALTO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE
CONSOLIDATED SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2002

WHEREAS, on November 5, 2002, a special election was consolidated with the gubernatorial general election and duly held in the City of Palo Alto pursuant to Article 1, commencing with Section 43600, of Chapter 4 of Division 4 of Title 4 of the California Government Code, or Article 4.5, commencing with Section 53506, of Chapter 3 of Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 5 of the California Government Code, for the purpose of submitting Measure D to the voters of the City, in the form set forth below:

CITY OF PALO ALTO MEASURE D

“To improve library and community services for children by expanding Children’s Library to provide needed space and safety repairs; rebuilding and expanding the Mitchell Park Library and Community Center for all community users; and, to meet current health and safety codes by making plumbing, heating, ventilation, and lighting system upgrades to 50-year-old systems in all three facilities, shall the City of Palo Alto issue \$49.1 million in bonds, subject to independent citizen oversight and annual audits?”

WHEREAS, due and legal notice of the special election was given as required by law; and

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of November 2002, at 7:00 a.m., the polls were duly and regularly opened for the gubernatorial general and special elections and the polls were continuously kept open until 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Registrar of Voters of Santa Clara County has conducted a complete and official canvass of the returns of the elections; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Palo Alto requires the Council to act as the canvassing board to canvass the results of such elections; and

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2002, the Council of the City of Palo Alto met at its usual place of meeting, canvassed the returns of the gubernatorial general and special elections and declared the results thereof;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Palo Alto does RESOLVE as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council finds and declares that:

(a) A special election consolidated with the statewide gubernatorial general election was duly and regularly held on November 5, 2002, according to the Charter of the City of Palo Alto, Ordinance No. 4757, and the election laws of the State of California for the purpose of considering Measure D.

(b) The total number of votes cast in the City at said Special Election, including votes cast upon absentee ballots, was 20,440 on 22,065 ballots (60.3% turnout);

(c) The total number of votes given and cast for Measure D at said election, including votes cast upon absentee ballots, was as follows:
