

ALTO City of Palo Alto Staff Report to Public Art Commission

January 14, 2016

RE: Agenda Item 1

Recommendation:

Staff recommends that the Public Art Commission accept the donations of artworks by Cubberley artists Linda Gass, Ken Edwards, Barbara Gunther, Nancy White, and Sahba Shere into the City collection.

Discussion:

These generous gifts are being offered by Gass, Edwards, Gunther, Shere and White as part of the Cubberley Artist Studio Program (CASP) agreement. According to the CASP Guidelines, all CASP artists are expected to donate one of his/her artworks in their first (4-year) residency term to the City's Public Art Program. Artists are asked to select three choices of work that best typifies your style, aesthetics and content interest.

Linda Gass

As a visual artist and environmentalist, Linda Gass is inspired by the connections between humans and the water and land that sustain them. In her work, she visually juxtaposes vulnerability and resilience, past memory and future possibilities. Gass's two main bodies of work include stitched silk paintings and land art installations. In her stitched paintings, she blends painting with textile techniques to create multi-layered birds-eye view landscapes and maps showing the human marks that affect our water resources. Gass also uses textiles in her land art installations. In some cases the textiles are placed in dry landscapes to create the illusion of water. In other cases the textiles play a symbolic role to illuminate the relationship between the present landscape and the past landscape.

The artwork, proposed for donation is a unique photographic image printed on coated aluminum. The original artwork, created in 2009, was purchased by a private foundation. This would be Gass's second gift to the City collection. In 2011, she also donated *Wetlands Musings*, a stitched painting on silk.

Ken Edwards

After thirty years as a firefighter Ken Edwards retired and pursued his artistic career. Always drawn to contemporary art, he began to experiment with materials he was familiar with — wood and paint — making sculpture, studio furniture and painting.

A self-taught artist, Edwards joined the Cubberley Artist Studio Program in 2003. His current CASP term will end later this year. He's been exhibiting regionally since 2000. This would be Edwards' second gift to the City collection. In 2008, he also donated a painting titled *Fracus at the Flan Factory*.

Barbara Gunther

Barbara Gunther is an artist and educator. She is a recipient of the Purchase award from Palo Alto Cultural Center, 1975; Judges' Merit award from the Haggin Museum, 1988; and a Member of California Printmakers Society and San Jose Institute of Contemporary Art. She taught printmaking and drawing at Cabrillo College, Aptos, CA, lithography at California State University, Hayward, and studio arts California State University, San Jose. Gunther is represented in permanent collections such as the San Jose Art in Public Places Program, Triton Museum, Santa Clara, California, Museum City New York, Santa Clara Law School, Foundation Press, and Chrysler Motors.

The quality of light and how it plays as it goes through barriers has been the main emphasis of her work for many years. Gunther has been with the Cubberley Artist Studio Program since 2003. She previously donated another work to the City Collection in 2011 titled *Rhododendron II*.

Nancy White

Artist Nancy White produces intimately-scaled and optically charged geometric abstractions that invite viewers to question their dimensionality, where the distinction between what is painted and what is seen is often elusive. Through the manipulation of basic, concrete elements like light and form, White's works— although small—make a big impact.


White, an accomplished and much-exhibited artist, was part of the CASP artist community for 13 years. In 2011 she donated an artwork to the City collection, in accordance with the Cubberley Studio Agreement.

Sahba Shere

A Palo Alto-based artist, Sahba Shere journals her travels around the world in painting. Her paintings are "a memory capsule of her travels, depicting the experienced sensations she experienced." Dynamic yet intriguingly subtle, Sahba's art becomes a meditative and sensory experience, developing an emotional bond with the viewer through the depth of presence that each piece possesses. Immersed in the mindfulness of Sahba's mark is a visual mantra of color and motion, layering a sense of place and deep feeling into a bold abstraction of color and texture. The artist paints with vigor and variety, using brushes, palette knives, and hands to build each piece as she allows the journeys of her life to guide and direct her work. Sahba creates her expressive paintings in mixed media on canvas, diving into each surface with a pure joy and exuberance for the rich hues and tactile qualities of her medium. Sahba joined CASP in 2014. This will be her first gift to the City collection.
