


## Political Engagement Events




Our Goal: Address the isolation, anxiety, and stress of teens exacerbated by the COVID-19 Pandem ic


#### Teen Mental Health

- Advocate for program s to reduce stress


#### In what ways has the COVID-19 pandemic affected your mental health?









#### Do you have any stressors in your life? If so, what are they?




#### Has your sleep pattern changed during the pandemic?



#### How many hours of sleep have you been getting?





