Jeanne: I put the request to Verizon Wireless and its vendors yesterday. I'll send the images in batches in order to avoid size problems. This first batch came in today, and shows three facilities in San Jose, and one in Fremont. I have not checked the zoning for each pole, but all but one appear to be adjacent to residences. The address of each pole is in the file name of the photograph. I will follow up with more photographs as they come in. The facilities in San Jose and Fremont show the Ericsson 6701 integrated radios/antennas without any shrouding as originally proposed by Verizon Wireless for Palo Alto.
