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Not since the Preliminary Hearing has anything been heard about the proposal for 660 University Avenue. In that time, the developers have agreed to slightly reduce the number of units to be built and modestly increase the percentage of *low income housing*.

On behalf of the approximately 50 residents of the Hamilton, which is adjacent to the south of 660 University, I would like to point out that even the reduced proposal will cause severe traffic and parking impacts on University Avenue, Byron Street, and Middlefield Blvd.

The first major impact will be from the congestion caused by adding several hundreds trips per day [regardless of what street is used for the entrance/exit for 660] University because the traffic will be trying to enter/exit the street from less than 1 block from the intersection. This intersection is already quite busy during most of the day, and adding additional ingress and egress turns so close of the intersection certainly cause severe congestion.

The second major impact will be the overflow traffic onto Byron Street for the cars from 660 University that want to turn left but will have to cross one lane of traffic to do so (again regardless of which street is chosen for the entrance/exit for 660) and instead will choose to make 3 right turns including one onto and one off of Byron, which is effectively a one-way street because of all the cars that park on it.

Finally because of the difficult entrance and exit into the parking garage, which will be under 660 University and because of the complicated stacking proposal for this garage parking, much, if not most, of the parking for 660 will attempt to be on-street, which will further congest both University and Byron streets.

The lower density and trees surrounding the intersection of Middlefield and University now offer a pleasant transition between the commercial sections on downtown University and the residential sections that stretch out to Highway 101. The proposed project will greatly reduce the trees and intensity (enlarge) the buildings around the intersection, thus making the transition much more abrupt and acute.

In summary, the proposed development at 660 University will cause both traffic and parking issues around the intersection of University and Middlefield, and will make the traffic and parking situation on Byron untenable. Since the residents near this area are mostly senior citizens, both their pedestrian and driving safety will be negatively impacted.

When this proposal comes before you, we urge you to restrict development to the current density, or certainly to no greater than the current density zoning.

Thank you for your consideration of this matter, which is of utmost importance to the residents of this area.
