CALL FOR ARTISTS CASP STUDIO RESIDENCY



- Artists seeking affordable studio space are encouraged to apply to the Cubberley Artist Studio Program (CASP), which provides four-year artist working studios at below-market rates for artists to create and use the space.
- These rent subsidized artist studios (not housing) are provided in exchange for artist-led free public programming, which contributes to the vitality of Palo Alto arts and a dynamic cultural destination.
- Artists living within the nine greater Bay Area counties are eligible, although Palo Alto residents have preference.
- Applications are due June 6 at 11:59 p.m.
