California Shifts Masking Recommendations to Use CDC Community Levels Beginning 9/23/22

- California shifted its masking recommendations to a framework intended to provide information and recommendations based on the unique circumstances happening within specific communities and counties.
- Moving forward, CDC Community Levels will inform state masking recommendations in all indoor settings at all times.
- County Public Health continues to strongly recommend wearing face coverings indoors in public settings.

- According to the CDC, you can get a COVID-19 vaccine and a flu vaccine at the same time if you are eligible, and the timing coincides.
- September and October are generally good times to be vaccinated against flu.
