Dear City Council:

Park dedication of the 2.01 acre Heritage Park by the City Council included the determination that none of that land was needed to provide parking for the Roth Building.

The development agreement between the City and the Palo Alto Medical Foundation approved by Ordinance No. 4627 provides only 60 spaces of parking on the first level of underground parking in the Homer/Bryant development for the public on Saturdays and Sundays from 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m., and for non-residential parking on weekday evenings between 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. (See paragraph K of Exhibit D-1 to the Development Agreement.)

The parking restriction should be taken into account when evaluating any public or private use of the Roth Building.
