Authority of Commission:

The Planning and Transportation Commission advises the City Council on the City of Palo Alto's Comprehensive Plan, land use, zoning, subdivision and other related policy matters.

The Board is responsible for:

- Preparing and making recommendations to the City Council on the City's Comprehensive Plan regarding development, public facilities and transportation in Palo Alto;
- Considering and making recommendations to the City Council on zoning map and zoning ordinance changes;
- Reviewing and making recommendations to the City Council on subdivisions, on appeals on variances and use permits;
- Considering policies and programs affecting development and land use in Palo Alto for final City Council action;
- Reviewing and making recommendations on individual projects like Planned Community Zones, Open Space development, and other projects as directed by the zoning code, staff and City Council

Please see Palo Alto Municipal Code Sections <u>2.16</u> and <u>2.20</u>, and <u>19.04</u> for more detailed information.

The Planning and Transportation Commission consists of seven members. Members must <u>not</u> be Council Members, officers, or employees of the City. Palo Alto residency is required. Terms of Commissioners will be for <u>four years</u> and a term limit of eight consecutive years.

The Planning and Transportation Commission meets on the second and last Wednesdays of each month at 6:00 P.M. In addition, Commissioners may be asked to participate on at least one sub-committee. Sub-committees may hold additional meetings.
