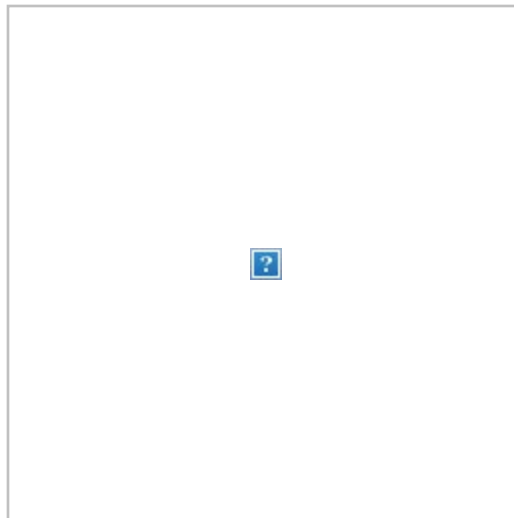
Sadly, such Israeli attacks during Ramadan and Passover have

6. What's on Your Bookshelf?

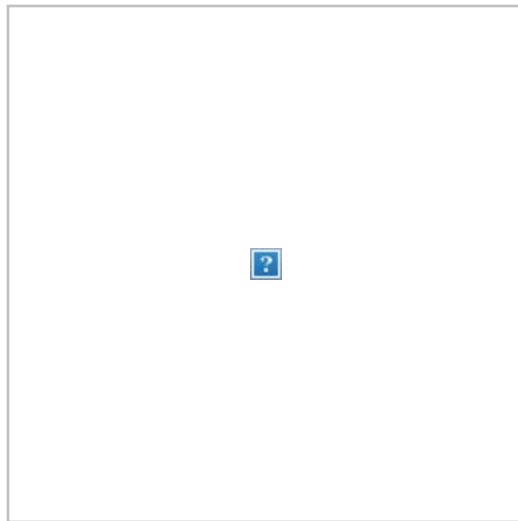
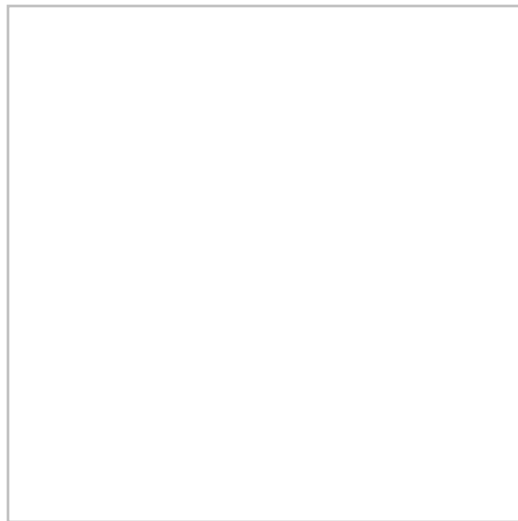
Earlier this month, we marked the 80th anniversary of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising, a definitive moment of bravery in Jewish history. I just finished reading "Five Years in the Warsaw Ghetto", a memoir by Bernard Goldstein, an organizer of the uprising, and a leader in the Jewish Labour Bund.

This is a heavy but crucial read. Some of the scenes that Goldstein witnessed during and after the war in Warsaw are unimaginably apocalyptic. But he notes towards the end that one of the few things driving him to survive was the hope that one day future generations would learn the stories of the war and the Holocaust.

I would highly recommend this book for anyone looking for a powerful first-hand account of the Warsaw Ghetto during WWII.

I go to the Avenidas Senior Center nearly daily. It is like a ghost center. Avenidas has at least four empty medium sized rooms for La Comida, four empty rooms nearly every day. They pay \$1/year rent to PA. They need to step up and bring La Comida back to the Senior Center asap. Folks now stand in long lines at the First Methodist Church. They must leave. There is not any place to go to share a meal, socialize, but they pick up a tray, and then go home. No place to socialize, to share ideas, make friends, etc.

AVENIDAS Senior Center on Bryant NEEDS TO SERVE THE SENIOR COMMUNITY BETTER! They are hardly serving the middle class of Palo Alto, and not serving working class folks or others who want to share a lunch with others for a small donation.

Check it out for yourselves. Go there and see how vacant it is. We can do better.

THEY CAN DO BETTER! Staff is pretty well paid. Let's serve seniors, ALL seniors.

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Impact on protected First Amendment rights: Law enforcement agencies have a history of misusing license plate surveillance to monitor First Amendment–protected activity. During the 2008 presidential election, the Virginia State Police recorded the license plate numbers of attendees at political rallies for Barack Obama and Sarah Palin — and subsequently at President Obama’s inauguration — and kept the data for more than three years until it was purged following an opinion from the Virginia Attorney General warning that ongoing retention would violate the state’s Government Data Collection and Dissemination Practices Act. ¹⁰⁰ Similarly, police in Denver spied on anti-logging activists and shared license plate information with the FBI’s Joint Terrorism Task Force when the activists held a training on nonviolence. ¹⁰¹

Such surveillance — whether it involves the locations of multiple cars that appear together in the same place, or of a single car at places like a mosque, synagogue, or rally — has a chilling effect on Americans’ First Amendment rights to freedoms of association, religion, and speech. ¹⁰² An investigation into an NYPD program that monitored mosque visitors’ license plates found that this surveillance “chilled constitutionally protected rights — curtailing religious practice, censoring speech and stunting political organizing.” ¹⁰³ The International Association of Chiefs of Police has noted that ALPRs can cause people to “become more cautious in the exercise of their protected rights of expression, protest, association, and political participation because they consider themselves under constant surveillance.” ¹⁰⁴ And there is always the specter of more flagrant abuse, such as putting a political opponent’s license plate on a hot list and using it to keep track of that person’s whereabouts. ■

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In the wake of nationwide protests that followed the police killings of George Floyd and Breonna Taylor, public attention has increasingly focused on the ongoing instances of police brutality and racial bias in policing. However, there is a risk that police departments and legislators may incorrectly propose surveillance as a neutral alternative. Surveillance that disproportionately targets communities of color carries a distinct and cognizable equal protection harm: branding them with a badge of inferiority. As one appellate court wrote, “Our nation’s history teaches the uncomfortable lesson that those not on discrimination’s receiving end can all too easily gloss over the ‘badge of inferiority’ inflicted by unequal treatment itself. Closing our eyes to the real and ascertainable harms of discrimination inevitably leads to morning-after regret.” ■

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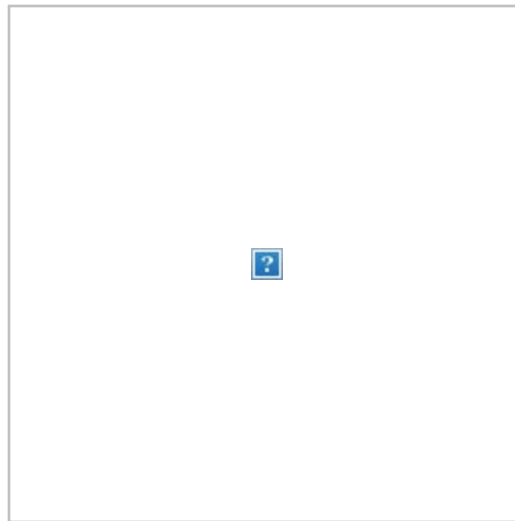
Dear Aram,

2. Sarah Jama byelection victory roundup

On March 16th, Ontario NDP candidate Sarah Jama won a byelection by a landslide in Hamilton Centre to become the riding's new Member of Provincial Parliament. IJV [extended a warm congrats](#) to her, the first ever Somali woman elected to office in Canada, and a powerful new voice for Palestinian freedom at Queen's Park.

As you may have heard, Jama's campaign was marred by racist smears and baseless accusations of antisemitism simply because of her support for BDS and Palestinian human rights.

IJV members were quick to come to Jama's defence, and circulated an

open [letter of support from Jewish Ontarians](#). Our members in Kingston were able to [meet with new ONDP leader Marit Stiles](#), and thanked her for her unwavering support of Jama's candidacy. We were also mentioned in a [front-page article](#) in the Hamilton Spectator.

Now that Jama has won, we know the real work has just begun, and we hope she can continue fighting for justice for all inside the halls of power.



3. Solidarity With Hassan Diab

Hassan Diab is a Canadian citizen and Ottawa resident who will be tried in absentia in France on April 3rd for a crime he did not commit. Hassan faces the possibility of an unjust extradition to France for a second time. Showing up for him and lending our solidarity now is more important than ever.

At this eleventh hour, there is still time to send a letter to MPs demanding that our government do the right thing: ensure that Dr. Diab is not extradited a second time. If you have not already sent your letter, please consider doing so by [clicking here](#).

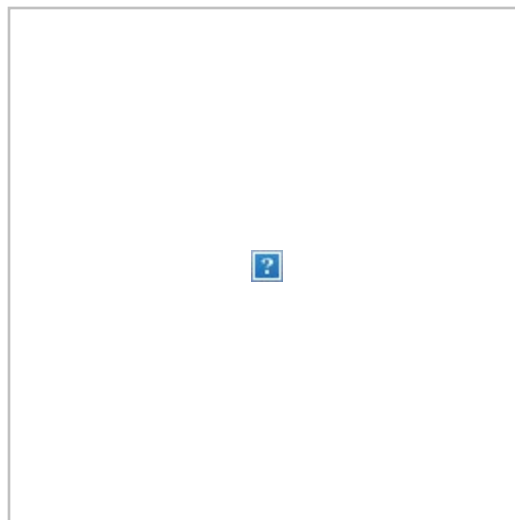
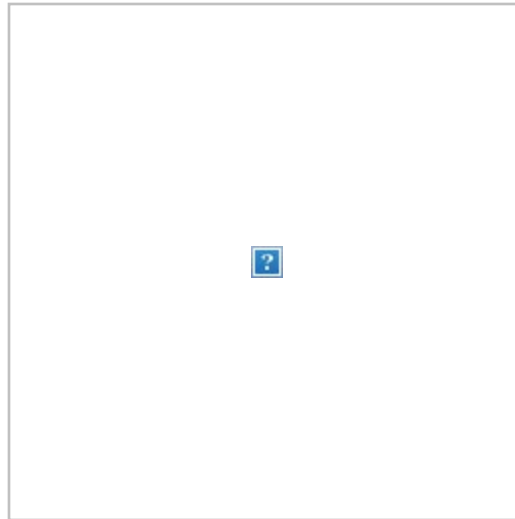

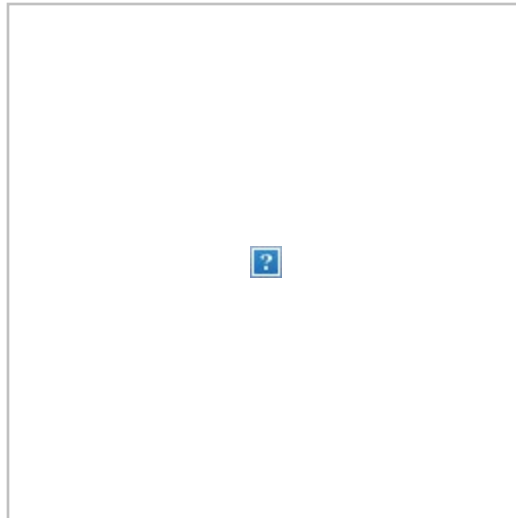

Because I am working and unable to attend this meeting, I would appreciate these comments being read into the public record with respect to Item 2 on the Commission's March 16, 2023 Meeting Agenda

Dear Commissioners –

My name is Kathleen Foley-Hughes. I am a 30-year Palo Alto resident, mother of four children who all went through Palo Alto schools, volunteer founder and creator of two vocational education programs for special day class students within the PAUSD at Terman (Fletcher) and Gunn and, the Founder and Executive Director of Ada's Caf.

Ada's Caf has operated as a 501(c)3, non-profit, social enterprise including a cafe at the Mitchell Park Community Center for the past 12 years. During this time, Ada's Caf has paid over \$1.2 million of liveable wages to 125 adults with developmental disabilities (including 83 who were Palo Alto residents) for tens of thousands of hours worked. We have done this with negligible government support and no program service revenue, relying instead on enterprise sales and local/community donations to support employment opportunities for this marginalized population.

On behalf of Ada's, our large community of Palo Alto donors and the tens of thousands of local customers who support our social enterprise with their commercial purchases, to see the staff report showing that Ada's is not being recommended to receive a single dollar is beyond

hurtful.

I appreciate and value the work done by all non-profits and I am not here today to disparage the efforts of others. But the message sent to Ada's and its community of supporters by the staff recommendation, and the Commission's prospective action on that recommendation, is simply irreconcilable with the work we do and the benefits we create every day for our mission-based employees, our local high school student interns and the community at large.

I recognize that allocating scarce resources is difficult, but I feel strongly that a process that results in Ada's Caf^e receiving \$0 while an organization with \$50 million in assets, an annual budget of over \$30 million and a CEO that is paid an annual salary of half a million dollars gets \$5,000, is seriously flawed.

Today, over 70% of Ada's employees are adults with developmental disabilities and 40% of those live in Palo Alto. This means that as we continue to grow back from COVID, we currently have 10 mission-based, Palo Alto resident employees.

The staff report says that Ada's is not recommended for funding because, "there is an imbalance between the amount of funding requested and the number of employees who would benefit."

In my opinion, the only way for a reviewer to reach this conclusion is for them to not fully appreciate what we do; how hard we work to create customer-facing jobs for employees with developmental disabilities, how meaningful those jobs and those paychecks are to those employees, or how much it costs to run a competitively commercial, food service business, let alone one with the added labor, insurance, and operating costs created by our non-profit mission. I also wonder if they fully appreciate the consequences of their resource allocation decisions to an organization like Ada's at a time like today, when private-sector, charitable support is being dramatically reduced because of economic and market conditions

Last May, I signed a [PETITION](#) in support of a \$500 Cap on donations to City Council candidates.

I am disappointed that no action was taken on this issue and hope that the new Council will enact the reforms proposed by the League of Women Voters of Palo Alto.

As most of us know, there is too much money in politics. The majority of our neighboring cities have already addressed this problem by passing ordinances setting \$500 or \$1000 caps on donations to city council candidates and also setting voluntary limits on campaign expenditures. Palo Alto should do the same.

I was pleased that three of the 2022 Council candidates voluntarily limited donations to less than \$1000, but it's time for this Council to set a cap that is mandatory going forward.

These reforms will help to bring down the spiraling cost of running for office in Palo Alto, level the playing field for diverse candidates, and reduce the sense that people with wealth have more sway over our Council members than ordinary citizens.

I look forward to seeing you pass an appropriate ordinance well in advance of the next election.

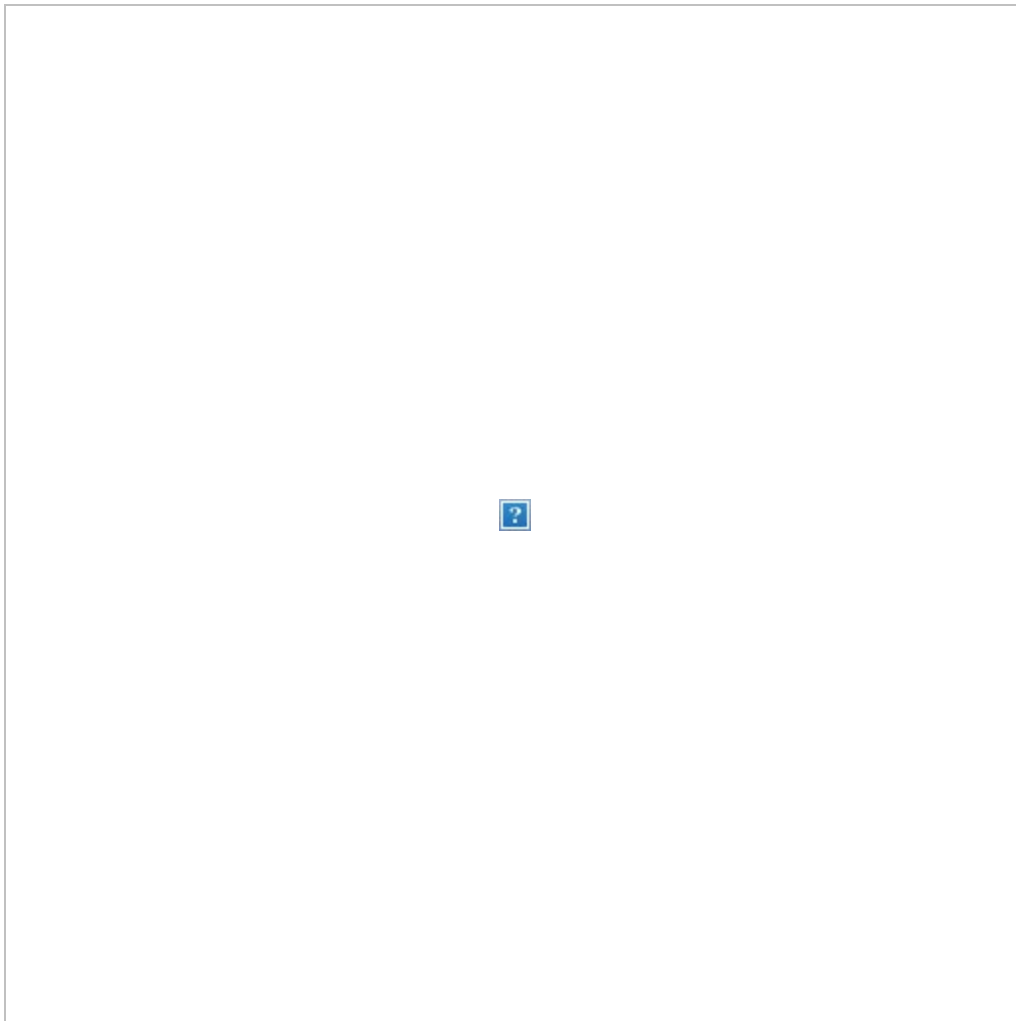

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Dear Aram,

For too long now, Palestinians and their supporters have been attacked, maligned and smeared simply because we've spoken out against Israeli apartheid, or in favour of BDS.

As we approach a provincial by-election in Hamilton Centre on March 16th, Ontario NDP candidate Sarah Jama has been caught

in the crosshairs of B'nai Brith Canada in a vicious smear campaign. B'nai Brith is alleging that Jama is antisemitic because of her commendable support for BDS and Palestinian human rights. What's more troubling is that they seem to be using the toxic **IHRA definition** as the barometer for concluding that Jama is antisemitic. This smear campaign against Jama, a Black woman, in the days leading up to a byelection is unfounded and racist.

We say these attacks are racist because there is a **documented pattern** of false accusations of antisemitism that the pro-Israel lobby overwhelmingly levels against people of colour. They perpetuate **anti-Palestinian racism**, and contribute to a climate of toxicity where racialized people are prevented from speaking out in support of other justice-seeking groups. Recall that earlier this month in Halifax, **Palestinian high school students were told** by the principal to take off their keffiyehs because they are a "sign of war".

Unfortunately, the allegations against Jama were **reported on uncritically** by Rob Ferguson at the Toronto Star. We encourage you to write a letter to the editor at the Star to refute the baseless attacks, and to remind them that calling for Palestinian liberation or supporting BDS isn't antisemitic. Send your letters (150 words max) to **lettertoed@thestar.ca**.

While these attacks are disheartening, I actually think that they make us stronger. As the old adage goes, an attack on one of us is an attack on all of us. When one of us gets smeared for speaking out for Palestine, 1000 more voices join the fold. And they only get louder.

With that in mind, don't forget to mark your calendars for IJV's [15th anniversary conference](#) in Toronto from June 16-18,

2023. It will be a historic opportunity to strengthen our intersectional anti-racist movements for justice, liberation and peace. I hope to see you there!

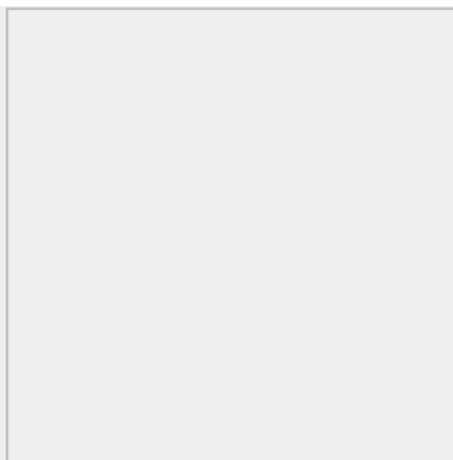

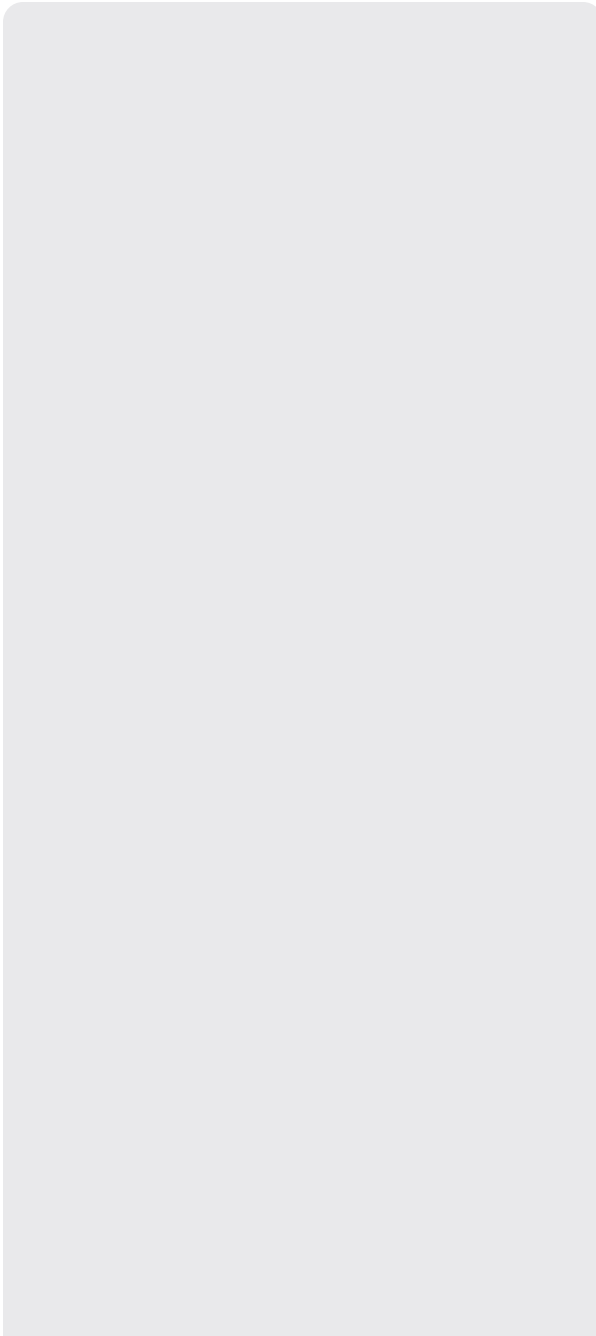
