

What was the biggest largemouth bass caught in the lake and when was it caught?

We have not kept records of size and type of fishes caught in Boronda Lake.

We do on occasion talk with fishermen who tell us about fish they have caught and if you believe fish stories many of them were **HUGE** fish.

I have seen many fish caught in the lake and have even caught a few myself. The largest that I have seen was caught on June 11<sup>th</sup> of this year right at park closing time (please plan on stopping fishing activities well before closing to avoid the possibility of citation). The fish was not measured or weighed but was slightly longer than the fisherman's forearm (about 20 inches) and at the belly was about as big around as a grapefruit. It was released back into the lake.

The biggest largemouth bass ever caught was caught June 2, 1932 by George W. Perry in Telfar County, Georgia and weighed 22 pounds, 4 ounces. Judging from the pictures, it was about 3 feet long.
