

If I found a baby squirrel in our backyard (possibly fallen from the tree) what can I do to help them? Where can I take them to? Can I bring them here?

If at all possible leave the animal alone. If in your best judgment it will not survive, or make it back to its home, you can take it to Wildlife Rescue, please do not bring them here (we will have to take it Wildlife Rescue and the extra time to get here and then there may be long enough for the animal to die).

Wildlife Rescue has a dedicated staff that is specially trained to take care of wild animals and ensure that they are capable of taking care of themselves. When the animal is grown and can be out alone, they try to release it back in to the wild as close to where it was found as possible.
