

Where can you hunt?

I presume you mean “Where can you hunt in Palo Alto Open Space?” the answer is easy: you can not.

All of the open spaces maintained by the City of Palo Alto are considered to be nature preserves, hunting is not permitted. Fishing is allowed in a few select areas: Boronda Lake at Foothills Park, Arastradero Lake in the Enid W. Pearson Arastradero Preserve, and near the nature center and the tide gate in the Baylands Preserve.

For those folks who are interested finding areas to hunt, I would suggest accessing the internet and checking out the California Department of Fish and Game website (which includes information on conservation, hunter education, lands and facilities available, licenses and permits):
