CITY OF PALO ALTO NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD FOR AMENDMENT TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN

The City of Palo Alto is proposing an amendment to its Community Development Block Grant Citizen Participation Plan, a document required for the expenditure of funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The clarifications are focused on the public hearings associated with the administration of the CDBG program.

A 15-day public review and comment period will begin on August 26, 2022, and end on September 10, 2022. Comments may be provided by phone or email via the contact information listed below for both English speakers and those with limited English proficiency.
