Dear Planning and Development Staff,

On behalf of Unity Palo Alto, and in partnership with MOVE Mountain View, we are applying to have unhoused residents living in four or fewer vehicles on our property's parking lot during the hours of 6pm to 8am with quiet hours from 10pm to 7am, although these hours may be shortened when school is in session. Bathrooms with washing facilities will be available to our vehicle residents during their parking times. In case of emergencies or complaints, please call MOVE Mountain View Lot Monitor directly at (650) 935-1141.

It is our intention to fully comply with the Safe Parking provisions set forth in PAMC 18.42.160 and to work with our vehicle residents, neighbors, church members, City staff, and MOVE Mountain View Staff to ensure our initial 90-day trial period is successful to enable further renewals of our application.
