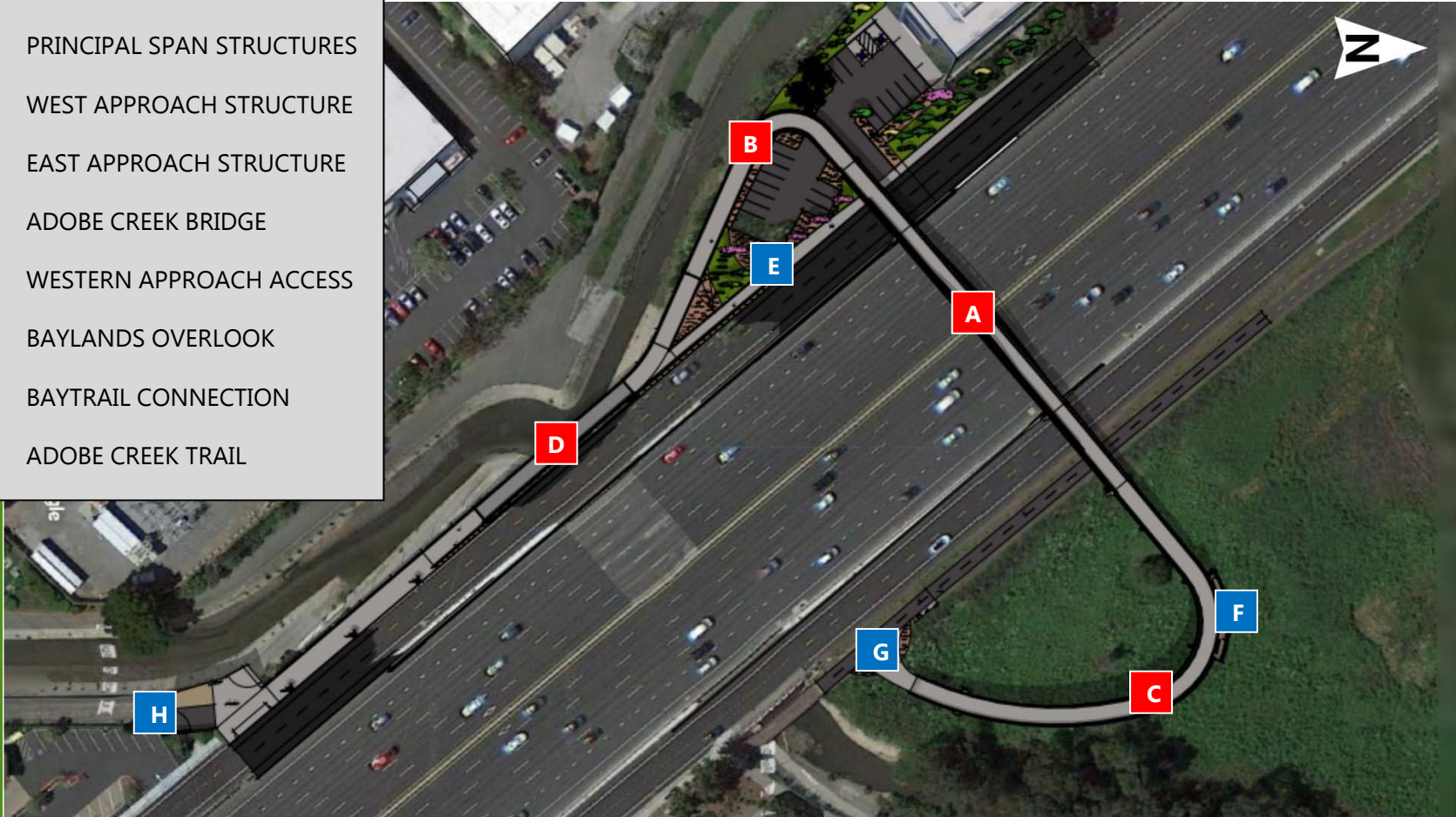

# Initial Study

- Mitigated Negative Declaration
- Mitigation Measures
  - MM AQ-1.1 - Construction generated dust
  - MM Bio-1.1 - Potential take of salt marsh harvest mice
  - MM Bio-2.1 - Nesting birds
  - MM Bio-3.1 - Bird population due to potential collision and lighting
  - MM Cul-1.1 – Cultural materials
  - MM Cul-1.2 – Discovery of human remains
  - MM Cul-2.1 – Tribal cultural resource
  - MM Haz-1.1 – Construction risk and spoils management
  - MM NOI-1.1 – Noise impacts

# Schedule and Next Steps

- **Phase 1: Preliminary Design**
  - 15% and 35% designs: Complete
  - IS/MND Circulation: September 1, 2017 – October 2, 2017
  - PTC approval of Site and Design: September 13, 2017
  - PRC Park Improvement Ordinance: September 26, 2017
  - ARB hearing: October 2017
  - CEQA Council adoption: November 2017
  - Caltrans NEPA and 65% design: Winter 2017
- **Phase 2: Final Design**
  - Right of Way, 100% design and Bid Documents: Fall 2018
- **Phase 3: Construction**
  - Construction: early 2019 to Spring 2020
