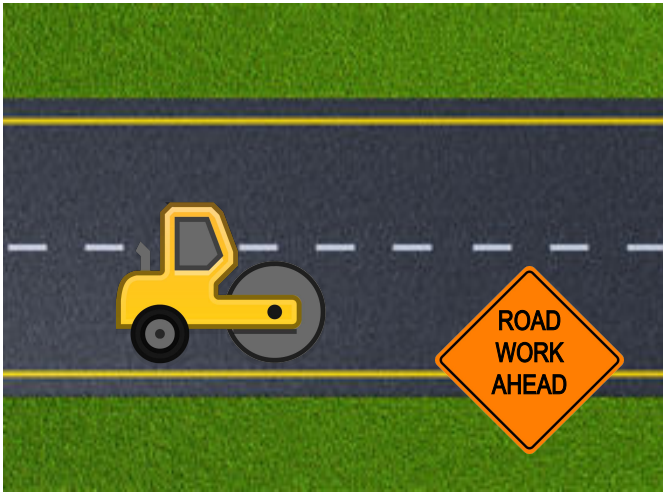

FY 2021 PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE PROJECT

PROJECT OVERVIEW

A slurry seal will be installed on your street by a private contractor who will be closely monitored by the City inspection team. A slurry seal is an application of a thin layer of emulsion containing oil and aggregate, which will seal the street surface to provide a new roadway surface and prevent further deterioration. Prior to the application of the slurry seal, the Contractor will perform preparation work that typically includes base failure repair, removal of existing striping and crack sealing.



STREET CLOSURE NOTIFICATIONS

"No Parking" signs attached to barricades will be posted 72 hours ahead of any work that will impact on-street parking.

Access to driveways may be temporarily blocked during base repair work that occurs in front of your driveway, these are marked with white paint on the street.

During the actual slurry seal, project streets will be closed to all traffic from 8 AM until 5 PM. Residents on these streets will be notified 7 days and again 24 hours prior to any street closures. The road will be restriped within 10 calendar days.

Saturday work and alternate work hours may be required as determined by the engineer.

IMPORTANT FACTS TO REMEMBER

! Please do not drive or walk on the newly applied surface treatment until the road has been reopened to through traffic, as doing so on fresh slurry will track the oil onto your shoes and clothes, car, driveway, sidewalk or adjacent roads and mark them permanently.

! If you will be traveling during the construction time period, please park your vehicles off the street or make arrangements for them to be moved if needed.

! If you are planning an upcoming major home construction project which requires the replacement or relocation of utility services, please call us at 650.329.2295 soon!

You may be able to save our time and your money on street cutting fees if we know of your plans in advance. This will allow the Public Works and Utilities Departments to coordinate the timing of your project, so the utility work can be completed before the road is slurry sealed. If we hear from you in time, this can result in a smoother, longer lasting street for everyone.
