October 2020 Parking Update

Due to Covid-19 Shelter-In-Place orders, parking restrictions in commercial and residential districts have been suspended since mid-March 2020. Enforcement has continued only for concerns that present an immediate hazard. As the County and State enter into phased re-opening, City of Palo Alto parking programs will soon begin transitioning back to normal operations.

To preserve neighborhood parking availability for residents as more businesses continue to adapt to COVID-19 impacts and reopen (9/21 City Council informational memo at <https://www.cityofpaloalto.org/civicax/filebank/blobdload.aspx?t=58444.96&BlobID=78463>), a phased approach to resuming parking program enforcement will begin on October 15th in select residential preferential parking (RPP) districts. See below for start dates and times for your RPP district. Commercial time restrictions, however, will continue to be waived while staff monitor parking availability and impacts. Please note that restrictions for red curbs, spaces designated for persons with disabilities, and any other locations prohibited by law are always in effect. If you have questions or need a permit, please contact the Office of Transportation.
