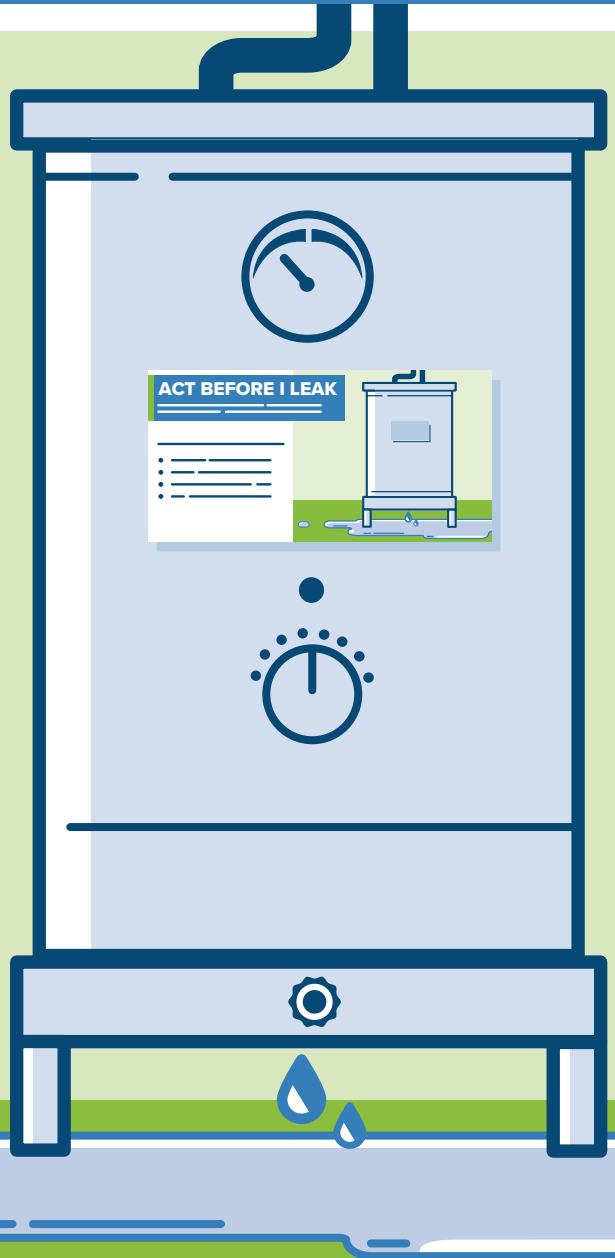


ACT BEFORE IT LEAKS
