Holiday cooking can leave you with a greasy cleanup, but don't pour cooking oil or grease down the kitchen sink! Grease solidifies and clogs pipes and causes sewer back-ups. Collect food scraps and small amounts of cooking grease and oil into the compost. For large amounts of cooking grease and oil, collect it in a container and bring it to a Household Hazardous Waste event for disposal. Events are held every Saturday from 9 am – 11 am or the first Friday of the month from 3 pm – 5 pm. Call (650) 496-5910 for more info.

Holiday Waste Collection Schedule GreenWaste provides regular scheduled collection service throughout the year except on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. If your regular collection day falls on or after one of these holidays, your collection day will be moved to the next day. Regular collection schedules will resume the following week. The following schedule applies:

- No collection on Friday 12/25/20 or 01/01/21.
- Collection will be rescheduled to the following day – Friday service will move to Saturday.
