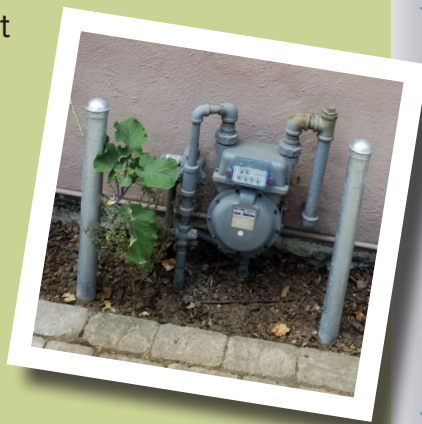


# We're Protecting Natural Gas Meters on Your Property by Installing Bollards.

**The Utilities Gas Meter Protection Program** is an ongoing safety project that installs bollards at various locations throughout the City. As part of citywide gas safety initiatives, and required by federal regulations, Utilities staff identifies gas meters that need to be protected from potential vehicular damage. Bollards are designed to protect gas meters, pipes and regulators against incidental bump damage during typical low speed vehicle movements in driveways, alleyways or parking lots.

This current phase of the project began in January 2020 and will be completed by the end of 2022.

Residents will be notified before City contractors install the gas meter protection bollards on their property around the existing gas meter.
